#### The man telling the story of the weather in photos

The man behind the lens is Alan Percy from Norwich. He's also known as Walking Tractor, one of the BBC's army of Weather Watchers. Armed with only his iPhone, Alan takes some amazing photographs. He shares his photos on Twitter and sends his weather photos to the BBC and ITV.

"You get people saying, 'I can't get out much and get everything else so thank you for sharing the beautiful world around you' and things like that and it really makes your day. It's like, you know, 'You are going out there' or 'It's too cold for me to come out there but it's lovely to see and share your walk this morning', so it's actually really nice to read those comments.

"Part of the Weather Watchers is you tell the story of the weather and this country doesn't have great weather all the time. You know, it's not sunshine and snow all the time so you get up and you tell the story that day, whatever the weather, and you learn to love any sort of weather conditions really."

Alan's top tips:

- 1. Capture the weather in your photograph
- 2. Take more than one photograph
- 3. Leave enough room for the weather presenter

"I used to be a keen painter years and years ago, water colours mostly, of countryside scenes, villages, and things like that, and so I've always, I suppose, been interested in composition to make sure that everything is balanced in a space and that helps with photography."

#### Elliott Erwitt on the art of photographic sequencing

Each photo is taken just moments apart with the sequence telling a story that is surprising, moving, or simply funny. The short stories about life, lovers, pets, and children were shot all over the world over the past 60 years.

In 2017, on the centenary of Russia's October Revolution, he spoke to the BBC about what it was like to witness two world leaders having a spat during the Cold War. "They were grandstanding – they were playing for their audience," he said of the moment.

As well as political standoffs, Erwitt was known for capturing sorrow (Jacqueline Kennedy at her husband's funeral), animals (especially dogs), and significant cultural moments. He told the BBC how patience is the key to getting a good sequence of photographs. It was Erwitt's firm belief that photography should speak to the senses and emotions rather than intellect.
