## FAST TRACK PASSPORT

If you are applying for a passport, it can take time. You have to complete and send in the necessary forms and wait for your passport to arrive. (0) <u>H</u> It means going to the passport office in person to present your application. The great advantage is that you have the guarantee that your passport will be with you within one week. That can help you make travel plans with confidence.

(4) \_\_\_\_\_ A member of your family will not be acceptable. Finally, make absolutely sure that all signatures are completely inside the boxes. (5) \_\_\_\_\_ This would slow down the fast track.

C – Unless you are in no particular hurry to have the passport.

D – You need a completed form, two kinds of identification, and two small photos.

G – This can be a colleague or a doctor, a teacher or some other person who knows you.

H – The fast-track service is an option for those who are in a hurry.
