The film draws heavily on Alfred Hitchcock's movie *The Lady Vanishes*, in which one passenger goes missing on board a train.

Flightplan is a thriller that tells the story of a mother's desperate hunt for her daughter. The story begins when Kyle Pratt (Judy Foster) falls asleep on an aeroplane. When she wakes up again, her daughter has disappeared.

Ordinary parents in that kind of situation might never find their child again. But Kyle Pratt is no ordinary mother. She is an aviation engineer, whose husband has died in Berlin. She and her daughter Julia are flying back to the USA with his body when the film opens. But nobody remembers seeing the girl on the plane. Worst of all, nobody really believes Kyle's story. Kyle persuades Captain Rich to search for Julia, but without success.

0/ Then Kyle starts searching by herself, but she causes problems, so the captain orders Carson – the security officer – to keep her under control. Kyle, however, knows every part of the plane and quickly escapes from Carson.

1/ _____ after Kyle's escape focuses on her effort to find Julia. Despite all the difficulties, she doesn't give up. And when 2/ _____ she locates the girl, she discovers a much bigger problem that affects the safety of all the passengers on the plane. But she can't tell anyone because they won't believe her. She must take action herself, especially when she is left alone with Carson, who is actually a hijacker. It is revealed that Carson, Stephanie, and the Berlin mortuary director have conspired to hijack the aircraft for a \$50 million ransom.

In 3/ _____, Kyle fights Carson, and against people who say she's crazy. Foster's performance is just amazing – she really captures Kyle's determination and intelligence. You really see the extreme emotions she goes through.
